Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- The nominee must be a resident of the City of Rockville.
- The nominee must not be employed by the City of Rockville.
- The nominee must have made a significant contribution to their community during the current calendar year.

The Good Neighbor Awards program is the City's way of thanking the residents who are committed to preserving, maintaining and improving the quality of life in their neighborhoods and our community.
