Overview

The Rockville Youth Commission (RYC) was formed in 2010 to advise the Rockville Mayor and Council on issues of concern to our youth. Discussion topics will include economic development, Town Center, pedestrian safety, human rights, environmental initiatives, recreation and parks, special events, traffic and transportation, City budget, master plans, land use policies, and zoning policies. The Youth Commission will also interact with other levels of government and elected officials on relevant matters. Youth Commission members will be responsible for regularly communicating any relevant news, events and activities to their respective schools/communities.

The Rockville Youth Commission will consist of 18 members in grades 9 through 12 who live and/or attend a school in the City of Rockville. Participants will serve a one-year term and may apply for reappointment through a formal process.

The Rockville Youth Commission is scheduled to meet monthly at Rockville City Hall at 111 Maryland Avenue, Rockville, Maryland 20850, on the second Thursday of every month (with the exception of our meeting in May to accommodate AP exam dates). The Rockville Youth Commission will follow the Montgomery County Public Schools closures or early dismissal policy due to inclement weather. All meetings will adhere to Roberts Rules of Order.
